



**DEAR FRIENDS OF THE NAPIER CENTRE 4 HEALING (NC4H),**

The Napier Centre 4 Healing is a non-profit organisation committed to walking alongside men who experience homelessness and substance dependency, helping them rebuild their lives and return to society as restored, dignified, and productive individuals.

Since opening our doors in 2019, we have accompanied many men on this journey of healing – supporting their recovery, reuniting them with their families, and equipping them with practical skills for meaningful employment.



To date, we have admitted 102 residents into the programme, of whom 91 have completed their time with us. Of these, 54 men have remained free from drugs and alcohol, while 37 have encountered setbacks and continue to need guidance and encouragement on their journey. We currently have 11 residents in the programme, bringing our present success rate to 59%. Behind each number is a testament to the power of care, structure, and compassion.

Because we serve some of the most vulnerable in our community, our programmes are offered free of charge to our residents. We rely entirely on the generosity of people and organisations of goodwill. In recent months, however, rising operational costs and a decline in regular donations have resulted in a monthly shortfall of approximately R80 000 between income and operating expenses.

Until now, this gap has been covered through carefully managed reserve resources. After a thorough review of our expenses, income, and operations – and having already reduced costs wherever possible – it is clear that this approach is not sustainable in the long term. In the interest of responsible stewardship and sound financial practice, we are seeking a solution that will secure the Centre’s future rather than erode it.

To help bridge this gap, we would like to introduce a new initiative called the **“200 Club”**.

**The vision is as follows:**

To bring together 200 caring and committed supporters, each contributing R200 per month on an ongoing basis, to help restore lives and give hope to those who need it most.

**From the anticipated R40 000 raised each month:**

- **R10 000** will be awarded as a first prize through a monthly lucky draw,
- **R4 000** as a second prize, and
- The remaining **R26 000** will go directly toward reducing the Centre’s monthly deficit and sustaining our daily work of care, recovery, and reintegration.



Even when a donor does not win a prize, their contribution continues to change lives – providing shelter, counselling, food, skills training, and the steady support that allows broken lives to be rebuilt with dignity.
